

On the website <https://bluelinehotel.com> (hereinafter, the website), we use cookies to facilitate the relationship between visitors and our content and to enable us to compile statistics on the visitors we receive. We inform you that we may use cookies to facilitate your navigation through the website, to distinguish you from other users, to provide you with a better experience when using the website and to identify problems in order to improve our website.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small files that are stored in the browser used by each visitor to our website so that the server can remember that user's visit when they access our content again at a later date. This information does not reveal your identity or any personal data, nor does it access the content stored on your PC, but it does allow our system to identify you as a particular user who has previously visited the site, viewed certain pages, etc. and also allows us to store your personal preferences and technical information. In accordance with Directive 2009/136/EC, transposed into our legislation by the second paragraph of Article 22 of the LSSI, and following the guidelines of the AEPD, we proceed to inform you in detail about the use of cookies on our website. Below is a classification of cookies according to a series of categories. It should be noted, however, that the same cookie may be included in more than one category.

Types of cookies according to the entity that manages them

First-party cookies: These are sent to the user's device from a computer or domain managed by the publisher. Third-party cookies: These are sent to the user's terminal from a computer or domain not managed by the publisher, but by another entity that processes the data.

Types of cookies according to the length of time they remain active

Session cookies: These are a type of cookie designed to collect and store data while the user accesses a website. Persistent cookies: These are a type of cookie in which the data remains stored in the terminal and can be accessed and processed for a period of time defined by the party responsible for the cookie, which can range from a few minutes to several years.

Types of cookies according to their purpose

Currently, most browsers are configured by default to block the installation of advertising or third-party cookies on your computer. The user can extend these origin restrictions to prevent the entry of any type of cookie, or remove these restrictions to accept the entry of any type of cookie. If you are interested in accepting advertising or third-party cookies, you can configure your browser accordingly. Clicking on the ACCEPT button shown in the initial information on cookies implies that you are expressly giving your consent to the party responsible for their use, and you may exercise your rights and revoke your consent at any time by sending a request to Vilera Turística SL.

Below you will find detailed information on all the cookies that may be installed on our website. Depending on your browsing habits, the configuration of your browser and your acceptance or rejection of cookies, all or only some of them may be installed. We

may update our website's cookie policy, so we recommend that you check this policy each time you visit our website to ensure that you are properly informed about how and why we use cookies. If you do not want cookies to be stored on your browser, or if you prefer to receive information each time a cookie installation request is made, you can configure your browser options accordingly. Most browsers allow you to manage cookies in 3 different ways:

Cookies are always rejected.

The browser asks if the user wants to install each cookie.

Cookies are always accepted.

Your browser may also allow you to control which cookies are installed on your computer. The user can usually accept one of the following options:

Reject cookies from specific domains.

Reject third-party cookies.

Accept cookies as non-persistent (they are deleted when the browser is closed).

Allow the server to create cookies for another domain.

To allow, detect, block or delete cookies installed on your computer, you can configure the options of the browser installed on your computer. Information on how to configure the most commonly used browsers can be found in the following locations:
